- Refrain from doing anything which constitutes a danger to themselves and others
- Immediately bring to the attention of relevant personnel any situations or practices that are noted which may lead to injuries or ill health
- Ensure that any equipment issued to them, or they are responsible for, is correctly used and properly stored
- Be responsible for good housekeeping in the area in which they are working
